
Winchester was once the capital of England and now offers a combination of historic architecture with modern British life to provide a truly authentic learning experience.



At ATC Winchester we know that everyone has different objectives and time available, and so you can study with us from one week to one year.

#### How we teach...

The curriculum is designed to develop the overall level of English, focusing on all the key skills of reading, writing, speaking, listening, grammar and vocabulary.

We adopt a varied approach, adapting to the needs of our learners and drawing on a range of materials. Using course books as a basis, we integrate a number of methodologies to suit our students' aims and abilities.

Each class has two teachers, exposing the students to different accents and teaching styles.



## **COURSE OPTIONS**

# We offer courses all year round for students of levels A2 to C1, Pre-Intermediate to Advanced, subject to demand and availability.

From September to June, classes of B2 and C1 use Cambridge exam preparation course books in their daily classes, developing their overall level of English.

In the 4 weeks leading up to an exam they can choose the exam skills option for focused preparation, in addition to self-study sessions and one to one tutorials.

Each class has two teachers, exposing the students to different accents and teaching styles.

### When can I study...

- General English
  - throughout the year starting every Monday except Bank Holidays (when courses start on the Tuesday) and for two weeks over the Christmas period when the school is closed. See website for school closure dates.
- Exam preparation courses contact us for dates or see our website.

In order to prepare fully for the Cambridge exams we recommend 12 weeks of study.

During the 4 weeks preceding an exam (IELTS and Cambridge exams) we offer additional support with extra input and opportunities for exam practice.

We arrange weekly creative sessions in the school, these are designed to promote learning English by 'doing', through various activities such as music, cookery, art workshops and creative writing.


